## FINANCIAL AID

St. Joseph School of Practical Nursing is approved by the United States Department of Education, Office of Post-secondary Education, and participates in the FFEL and the Federal Pell Grant programs.

The FFEL programs include the Federal Stafford Loan (subsidized and unsubsidized) and the Federal PLUS loan. The Federal PLUS loan is available to parents of dependent students.

The Federal Pell Grant Program consists of gift moneys given to students based on their demonstrated financial need. Unlike the FFEL loans, Federal Pell Grants do not have to be paid back.

St. Joseph School of Practical Nursing is also approved by the New Hampshire Post-secondary Education Commission for NH Incentive Grants, NH Leveraged Nursing Grants, and Veteran's Benefits.
