## FINANCIAL AID

St. Joseph School of Nursing Associate of Science in Nursing program is approved by the United States Department of Education, Office of Postsecondary Education, and participates in the Federal Family Education Loan (FFEL) programs and the Federal Pell Grant.

The FFEL programs include the Federal Stafford Loan (subsidized and unsubsidized) and the Federal PLUS loan. The Federal PLUS loan is available to parents of dependent students.
