## FINANCIAL AID

St. Joseph School of Nursing Practical Nursing program is approved by the United States Department of Education, Office of Postsecondary Education, and participates in the Federal Family Education Loan (FFEL) programs and the Federal Pell Grant.

The FFEL programs include the Federal Stafford Loan (subsidized and unsubsidized) and the Federal PLUS loan. The Federal PLUS loan is available to parents of dependent students. The Federal Pell Grant Program consists of gift moneys given to students based on their demonstrated financial need. Unlike the FFEL loans, Federal Pell Grants do not have to be paid back.
